## Virginia Regional Mission Trip

Our Regional Mission Advance Team returned home from a 3-day Trip to Western NC to plan our June 15-20 Third annual Multi-generational Regional Mission Trip on Wednesday March 35, 2025. They met with Seven partners and toured worksites. Our advance team consisted of Diane Clark and Suzanne Dale from Bon Air Christian and Rev. Dr. Jonathan Webster. On our June trip, we will break up into teams of 8 to 10 people and will be working with two different local Habitat for Humanities building new homes, repairing homes, serving at a food bank, serving a meal to the homeless, sorting donated items, and rebuilding bridges and trails at Christmount. In addition, all mission trip participants will help build a home in the parking lot of Christmount to be gifted to a hurricane survivor and will be doing various other small projects for hurricane survivors.

We have 82 registered including 14 youth (Ages 11-17) 9 young adults (Ages 19-29), Registration is now closed "There is no room in the Inn" every bed is full. We are an official Week of Compassion volunteer team. Each evening, we will have worship led by our youth and young adults, we will have morning watch and devotional times at lunch. We also have a couple of educational programs, will have some fun including gaga ball, pickle ball and spider ball.
