A Resources share from the Regional Minister in Great Rivers Region

The water crisis in Jackson is a fast-moving, fluid situation. We know that South Jackson will be the most heavily impacted zone of the city, being both economically depressed and being the furthest point from the pumping stations. New Horizon Church International has arranged to be the S. Jackson distribution point for water. The biggest need is for water donations, both potable and non-potable, as soon as possible. If you have resources (church groups, businesses, concerned individuals, etc.) that can donate bottled water, we need to get it to New Horizon for distribution ASAP. They have the facilities to handle everything from a case of bottled water up to a semi-truck. The address for New Horizon is: 1770 Ellis Ave., Jackson, MS 39204. Dear All.

I will keep this message direct and brief with the hope that you will read it and join me in one or more of the following goals for our ministry together in the Virginia Region:

- 1. Plan and hold a Clergy Gathering (Looking for a team to plan it)
- 2. Synthesize the standing requirements between PDC, Virginia and North Carolina to bring about a better experience of wholeness for all. (Currently PDC clergy in North Carolina are given standing through Virginia while their congregation is cared for by North Carolina.)
- 3. Establish and rebuild a full region wide youth ministry (possibly with the help of University of Lynchburg).
- 4. Encourage and establish more District gatherings throughout the region (Together we are stronger).
- 5. Make it easier and accessible for churches/ministries to apply for grants to enhance their ministry (Anti-Racism, New Church and the newly established Dream Grants made possible through sale of the Summit).
- 6. Increase the bookings at Craig Springs to protect the overall camping ministry of the whole region.
- 7. Encourage and hold at least 10 Anti-Racism/Pro-Reconciliation trainings/ experiences throughout the region (need churches/districts to host these events).
- 8. Continue to focus on and create new support for the Mental Health ministry in the region (events and connection between mental health professionals).
- 9. Establish ongoing Lunch Learning events via zoom on topics that enhance and support local congregational ministry (i.e., topics from regional assembly, introduce wider church ministry resources, and other practices essential to healthy churches).
- 10. Encourage more churches to develop a "Campus" approach to ministry by working with nearby Disciples congregations. Together we can do more. (Ask me about this one and the related new ministry approach that has been requested by young families.)
