Richmond, VA – Seventh Street Christian Church invites the community to a heartfelt final worship service at its long-standing location of 4101 Grove Avenue on Saturday, April 26, 2024, at 3:00 PM. This special gathering will highlight the church's rich history, acknowledge its current transformation, and celebrate the many memories created within its beloved walls. Rev. Dr. Terri Hord Owens, General Minister and President of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) will be preaching at the service.

As the church reflects on its past, it is essential to honor the foundation laid by the early leaders of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), including Thomas and Alexander Campbell, whose visits inspired the formation of Sycamore Christian Church in the 1830s. The congregation built a dedicated space officially becoming Seventh Street Christian Church on July 14, 1872. Over the years, the church has nurtured generations of faith and community, ultimately relocating to its current site at Malvern & Grove in September 1950 in response to significant growth.

In its mission to invest more in the community, Seventh Street Christian Church is currently navigating a significant transition by selling its property and moving worship to a temporary space. This decision allows the church to direct more resources—time, energy, and finances—into enhancing community outreach and stewardship.

As we gather to commemorate this significant moment, we invite former ministers, parishioners, friends, and community members to join in this celebration of gratitude. Join us for this momentous occasion as we express our appreciation for the past while looking forward to new opportunities to serve our community.

District IV Board Meeting

The District Board meeting was held on 2/10/25 at 7:00 pm. There were 18 members in attendance with 12 churches represented. There were no minutes presented for approval.

The interim treasurer, Robert Smith, reported that the balance brought forward from 2024 was \$3404.78. Church dues/contributions were remitted by Doe Run CC and Jerusalem CC for a total of $\frac{85.00}{53489.78}$ bringing the balance to \$3489.78. Churches were reminded to make their individual dues/contributions.

Business included:

An announcement was made that the pastor from Corinth CC, Chatham, VA, Rev. Gary Page, had passed away in late January.

Flo reported that Rocky Mount CC, Boones Mill CC and Doe Run CC's, will be combining choirs for an Easter cantata to be performed at Boones Mill CC on 4/12/25 and Rocky Mount CC on 4/18/25 at 7:00 pm respectively.

Rev. Jordan Smith-Arrington reported that Boones Mill CC is supporting Franklin County Foster Care programs by providing needed items when children and staff must live at the facility until children can be placed with families. Boones Mill CC is also doing a fund raiser to update/refurbish the family meeting room at the Social Services office.

Rev. Scott Oliver from Snow Creek CC thanked the churches and individuals who participated in the District Advent Service held 12/29/24 that concluded the calendar year. Rev. Oliver was especially grateful for the musicians from Boones Mill CC and Rocky Mount CC who sang, played instruments, and accompanied the hymns. Boones Mill had a female quartet to sing and a flute player for several special instrumentals. Many attendees participated in the scripture readings. The Snow Creek CC family provided an amazing and most delicious soup/chili lunch and homemade cookies for dessert. Small gifts were given to individuals at the conclusion of the service from the district by the Moderator, Marilyn Whittaker and the secretary Marquitta Joyce.

A Black History Program will be held at the Piedmont District, Reidsville NC, 2/23/25 at 3:00 pm.

Information regarding the Boundaries Workshop on March 15 has been mailed to all District Churches. This will be held in Martinsville at the New College Institute. It was recommended that all church leadership should attend to include those working with youth and children.

The General Board of DOC has requested three representatives be established from each congregation to participate in DOC business. Some Ministers participating in our zoom meeting had not received this information.

The General Assembly will extend to meeting in person every three years (due to cost) after July 2025 and convenes in Memphis, TN, July 12-15th. The goal is to have three members from each congregation represented. This is for the larger church to stay more connected and congregations have more participation in the larger church.

The Bylaws Revision Committee was established in 2024 but had not met. Members are Rev. Scott Oliver, Marquitta Joyce and Mabel Peters.

The Craig Springs camp schedule is posted on the Region website.

The Piedmont district camp schedule was not available. Rev. Kara Fleurigard will report later.

Rev. Mike Carrow, pastor of Calvary CC retired 12/31/24 and retired as District IV treasurer after serving for fifteen years. The Board voted to present a plaque of thanks and dedication for his years of service along with a $\frac{50.00}{50.00}$ gift card to his favorite restaurant.

Rev. Robert Smith, pastor of Jerusalem CC retired 12/31/24.

There were no Disciple Men or Youth reports. The Disciple Women reported: a very successful retreat was held in October at Smith Mountain Lake- 4-H Center. The theme was "Sowing Seeds of Faith." The retreat hosted an Anti-Racism Pro Reconciliation workshop conducted by the VA Region on Friday prior to the retreat. Mount Olive East CC Disciples Women are celebrating 50 years of Disciple Women Ministry with a special recognition on 2/16/25. The VA Disciples Women's Cabinet met 2/08/25 at the Regional Office in Lynchburg.

The District IV CC in VA 2025 calendar was presented. District IV will host another Picnic on 9/2025 and it was requested that all churches put this date on their calendars now to increase participation.
