Ceiling Work:

Couch Room: Build 2x4 matrix on ceiling and enclose with Beadboard, remove light fixtures as needed

Kitchen: Fill in already built Matrix frame to fit 4X8 sheets of beadboard, install beadboard on ceiling

Large/Main Meeting Room and Small Meeting Room: Cut beadboard to size, install beadboard over already in place 2x4 runs that cover water lines

Bathroom: Remove light, patch large holes in ceiling, reinstall light

Lower floor Drop Ceiling: Remove ceiling, place in dumpster/Trailer

Painting: Kitchen walls: Full repaint walls white, protect floor with covering, lower hallway Trim with same trim color as 2nd floor (Project Leader Kitten Whitlow)

Lightbulbs: Replace all lightbulbs with LEDs, replace light cover over stairs, switch chandeliers between lower and upper lounges

Sidewalk Work: Remove section that is unlevel and broken, create frame for pouring new section ,mix/Pour and level new concrete

Declutter Work: Declutter and sort 3 lower rooms, clean and prepare for bedrooms, remove heavy Piano from meeting room, remove Ice machine from meeting room

Metal Stairs Exit: Power wash steps, paint and apply Sand traction paint on steps

Shelves in Kitchen: Build pipe structure for shelves, add boards, place dishes on shelves

Locks on Doors: Install new locks on doors

Stain Glass above all doors: Looking for someone or multiple people to build/donate stained glass sections, install/hang above doors for a unique look
